Order

In terms of Section 14(1) of the NCTE Act, 1993 K.K.M. College, Pakur, Jharkhand-816107 had submitted an application to the Eastern Regional Committee of NCTE for grant of recognition for starting B.Ed. Course of One year duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 200.

2. On scrutiny of the application submitted by the institution, the documents attached therewith, the inputs received from the visiting team, the Committee has noted the following:

- i. The institution has acquired the land for setting up the teacher education institution.
- ii. The institution has constructed the building for conducting the course on the above mentioned land
- iii. The institution has selected 07 (seven) faculty members for the said course and the list of teaching is duly countersigned by the affiliating university.

3. Now, therefore, in exercise of the powers vested under Section 14(3) (a) of the NCTE Act, 1993, the Regional Committee hereby grants recognition to K.K.M. College, Pakur, Jharkhand-816107 of one year duration from the academic session 2005-2006 with an annual intake of 100 (one hundred) students subject to the compliance of the following conditions before the commencement of the course:

- a) The institution will ensure that Principal/ HOD and at least 07 (seven) faculty members duly qualified as per NCTE norms are in position for an intake of 100 students before the commencement of the course and a report to this effect shall be sent the Eastern Regional Committee within one month of the commencement of the course.
- b) The institution shall submit a list of teaching staff duly countersigned by the competent authority of the University within one month of the commencement of the course.
- c) The institution shall pay salary to the teaching staff as prescribed by State Govt./UGC.
- d) The institution shall within one month of the receipt of recognition order, convert the Endowment Fund account into a Joint Account in the form of FDR for a period of not less than 60 months (five years) in a Nationalised Bank to be operated along with an official of the Regional Committee.
- e) The institution shall create a Reserve Fund for an amount equal to three months salary of the teachers and staff within one month from the date of issue of this order and maintain in the form of FDR in favour of the management of the Institution for a period of not less than sixty months (five years) in a Nationalised Bank.
- f) The institution shall adhere to all the other regulations and guidelines as framed by NCTE from time to time.

4. Further, the recognition is subject to fulfillment of all such other requirements as may be prescribed by other regulatory bodies like UGC, the State Government etc.

5. The institution shall submit to the Regional Committee a Performance Appraisal Report at the end of each academic year along with a copy of the approval of the affiliating body to the appointment of faculty members, and the statement of annual accounts duly audited by a Chartered Accountant.

6. If the institution contravenes any of the above conditions or any of the provisions of the NCTE Act, Rules, Regulations and Orders made or issued thereunder, the Regional Committee may withdraw the recognition under the provisions of Section 17(1) of the NCTE Act.

ORDER.

WHEREAS, K.K.M. College, Pakur, Jharkhand-816107 (Code No.APE00436) was granted recognition by ERC, NCTE on 07.09.2005 for conducting B.Ed. Course of one year duration with an annual intake of 100 from the academic session 2005-2006 subject to fulfillment of some conditions mentioned therein.

2. AND WHEREAS a Public Interest Litigation vide W.P.(PIL) No.327 of 2011 filed by Shiv Shankar Munda -Vs- Chairperson NCTE & Ors in the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand at Ranchi. As per direction of the Hon'ble High Court of Jharkhand, the said Institution was inspected by the NCTE Hqrs., New Delhi under section 13 of the NCTE Act 1993. Accordingly, the NCTE Hqrs. issued a deficiency letter to the institution along with the report of the Prof. Arora Committee for greater clarity of the deficiencies vide No. 93-41/2014/NCTE/Insp./A87045 dated 23.04.2014 on reasons mentioned therein.

3. AND WHEREAS after considering the matter in various meetings, the ERC in its 175th meeting held on 09.09.2014 considered the facts on records available in the file, the inspection report of the NCTE Hqrs. as well as reply submitted by the institution dated 04.07.2014 and 26.07.2014 in response to ERC's show cause notice U/S 17(1) dated 03.07.2014 and as decided by ERC, withdrawn order was issued to the institution vide No.27379 dated 24.09.2014 from the academic session 2015-2016 in terms of Section 17(1) of NCTE Act 1993 on the following grounds.

- (i) The institution does not fulfill the laid down Norms regarding Infrastructural and instructional facilities.
The institution has not adhered to the prescribed Norms regarding engagement of teaching and non-teaching staff and their service conditions.
- (iii) The management of instructional programme in the institution is not satisfactory.

4. AND WHEREAS the institution preferred an appeal to the NCTE Hqrs. against the ERC's order dated 24.09.2014. The Appellate Authority vides order No.89-359/2014-Appeal/2nd Meeting-2015/3837 dt.05.05.2015 remanded back the case to ERC with a direction to consider the matter by causing inspection on payment of fee.

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5. AND WHEREAS the ERC in its 188th meeting held on 19-20 May 2015 considered the appeal order dated 05.05.2015 along with original file of the institution and as decided by "–"; ER L, a letter was issued to the institution dated 27.05.2015 and thereafter receiving the resp. from the institution dated 18.06.2015, inspection letter to the institution was issued on 07.07.2015.

6. AND WHEREAS the ERC in its 191st meeting held on 14-15 July 2015 considered the letter dated 26.05.2015 received from the Director of Higher Education, Government of Jharkhand committed that all such requirements along with appointment of full time faculty will be complied with as per new Regulation 2014 by 31.10.2015, wherein the ERC has decided as under:

- I. Recognition of the institution be continued.
- II. Review the status will be taken up after 31st Oct.2015. Deficiency found if any after inspection will be communicated to the institution, concerned University and State Government for compliance.
- III. If the institution fails to comply the deficiencies, further course of action shall be taken as per norms.

7. NOW THEREFORE, the recognition of the institution viz. K.K.M. College, Pakur, Jharkhand-816107 (Code No.APE00436) for B.Ed. Course is allowed to continue.
